- Managing the developing and delivery of research projects
- Representing the PRI at external events

The successful candidate will be have a strong understanding of investment practice, the structure and operation of the investment chain and the issues relating to sustainable financial markets, and the incorporation of ESG into investments. Further to this they will also have:

- Demonstrable experience in designing and delivering research and policy work relevant to responsible investment or sustainable financial markets
- Proven track record in advocacy and public/market policy work
- Experience developed in an investment institution, a think tank, regulator, or government body relevant to financial markets is highly desirable
- A commitment to the SRI goals of the United Nations

This is a newly created role that is central to the PRI's ambition to become a preeminent global investor organisation focused on accelerating the transition to a more sustainable global financial system.
