OVERVIEW

PRI in Person is the leading annual global responsible investment conference, organised by the Principles for Responsible Investment. For the first time in 2014, PRI in Person and the PRI Academic Network conference will be held back-to-back in North America over the week of 22-26 September 2014 at the Hilton Bonaventure Hotel in Montréal, Canada.

The PRI is currently working with partners to arrange a full week of responsible investment-related activities for delegates attending this year's event, including several side events and site visits for delegates, possibly to Canada's tar sands and Hydro Quebec, the world's largest hydroelectric energy producer. PRI IN PERSON (24-26 SEPTEMBER)

More than 600 delegates are expected to convene in Montréal to network and discuss their progress and challenges in implementing the Principles. The agenda will include experts from the PRI signatory body and beyond. PRI in Person emphasises peer-to-peer dialogue and networking, aimed at sharing emerging best practise ESG integration, voting and engagement strategies.

Sessions and workshops typically include in-depth discussion of the challenges implementing the Principles in specific asset classes and identify new opportunities for collaboration among investors. Previous conferences were held in Rio de Janeiro, Paris, San Francisco, Sydney and Cape Town. A welcome drinks reception will be hosted on the evening of Wednesday 24 September, followed by a gala dinner on Thursday evening and senior leaders (CEO/CIO/CFO) lunch on Friday.

PRI ACADEMIC NETWORK CONFERENCE (22-24 SEPTEMBER)

Hosted in the same week as PRI in Person, this year's Academic Network conference will 'bridge the gap' between academics and investors globally. Investors will benefit from presentations and discussions on the latest research supporting responsible investment activity, and academics will have an opportunity to meet directly with investors to better understand where future research efforts need to be directed. The 2013 Academic Network conference in Paris attracted representatives from 60 universities. 40 original papers were presented and seven academic prizes were awarded.
